- Case 1 F.35 with resection of uterine mass.
- Case 2 M.61 with 12 cm. mass in lesser curvature of stomach.
- Case 3 F.59 with large mass in the right axilla.
- Case 4 F.62 undergoes lung transplant for interstitial lung disease. The explanted lung is shown.
- **Case 5** F.34 with morbid obesity presents with a 15 cm. ovarian mass.
- Case 6 1 day-old baby presents with a 1.5 cm nodule in the tongue.
- Case 7 M.40 presents with 8 cm. neck mass.
- Case 8 M.57 presents with rapid swelling of his left testicle.
- Case 9 F.21 presents with a mass in deep pelvis involving the obturator extremus muscle.
- Case 10 F.54 presents with a right breast nodule and subcutaneous nodule in her thigh.
- Case 11 F.67 presents with polypoid, large solid tumor protruding from the uterine cervix.
- Case 12 F.58 undergoes a total thyroidectomy for goiter.
- **Case 13** F.40 has multiple leiomyomas removed on hysterectomy.
- Case 14 M.44 with NF1 presents with multiple gastric polyps.
- Case 15 M.19 with subcutaneous nodule in the arm.
- **Case 16** F.80 with hepatic failure the slide is from the liver at autopsy.
- Case 17 M.55 presents with a large anterior mediastinal mass.
- Case 18 F.32 presents with palpable right breast mass.
- **Quiz Case 1** F.65 with remote history of breast carcinoma presents with a diffusely enlarged thyroid gland.
- **Quiz Case 2** F.57 with history of bilateral kidney and lung transplantation with multiple episodes of cellular rejection, MRSA infections and progressive respiratory failure that require a unilateral lung transplant. The slides are from the last lung explant.
