## AMR SEMINAR #65 SHORT SUMMARY OF CASES

**Case #1** – 79-year-old man was diagnosed with a large ulcerated cecal tumor.

**Case #2** – A 50 year old woman had a hysterectomy and bilateral salpingo-oopherectomy for uterine leiomyomas and adenomyosis. She later developed a large pelvic mass.

**Case #3** – An 11 year and eight month-old male was seen for a large liver tumor.

Case #4 – A 60-year old female presented with a 1.5cm well-circumscribed breast mass.

**Case #5** – A 32 year old man underwent total colectomy for refractory ulcerative colitis.

**Case #6 –** A two-year-old female child presented with hematuria and a left renal mass.

**Case #7** – A 62-year-old with multi-organ failure dies. At autopsy, there was cardiomegaly.

**Case #8** – A 47 year old male presented with a polypoid mass in the left maxillary sinus.

Case #9 – A 67-year old lady developed bluish skin lesions on both breasts.

Case #10 – An 81 year old lady was seen for a 2.4 cm. nodule in her breast.

Case #11 – A 20 year-old woman was seen for an irregularly pigmented lesion of the back.

**Case #12** – A 25 year-old female had a hysterectomy for a clinically fibroid uterus following a biopsy diagnosis elsewhere of leiomyosarcoma.

**Case #13** – A 71-year-old man was seen for a 4 cm. mass of his left kidney.

**Case #14** – A 93 year old woman presented for evaluation of a rapidly growing mass of the left upper eyelid.

**Case #15** – A 54-year-old female underwent partial resection of the right kidney for an asymptomatic tumor.

**Case #16** – A 53-year-old man presented with a tumor on the dorsal surface of his right foot.

**Case #17** – A 64 year old woman presented with a subcutaneous tumor on the right neck  $4.5 \times 4 \times 2$  cm.

**Case #18** – A 56 year-old man was seen for evaluation of a large retroperitoneal mass.

**Case #19** – A 24-year-old man is seen for a vascular mass on the right side of the neck.

Case #20 – A 44 year old man was seen for a solid 6 cm. tumor of the kidney.

**Case #21** - A 33 year old male with a right axillary mass.

Case #22 – A 64 y.o. lady that was diagnosed in her homeland with infiltrating ductal carcinoma of the breast.
